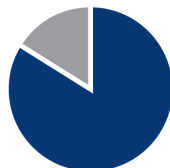

There is a staff member at my school with whom I feel comfortable talking	84%



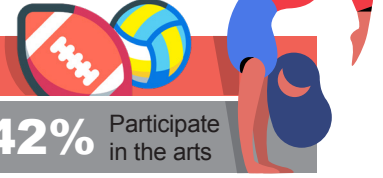
