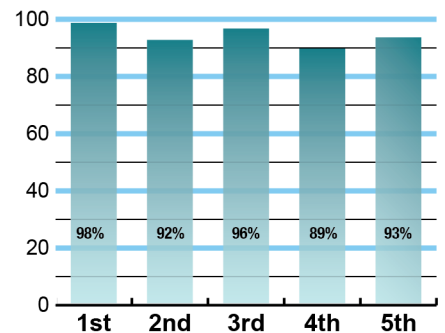

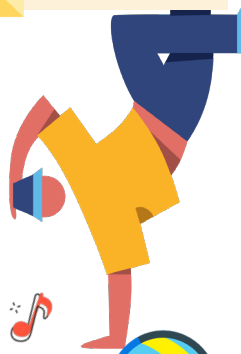
DIGITAL CITIZENSHIP
