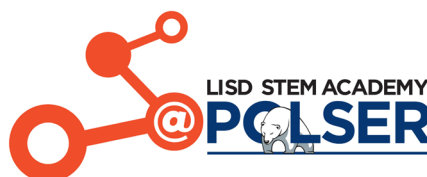

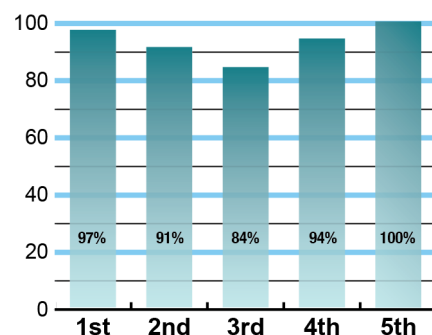
We believe students, staff and community design and implement a learning organization that provides engaging, innovative experiences every day.
