In April 2024, seniors were asked about their future readiness and post-graduation plans. Values represent the percentage of students who agreed with each statement.

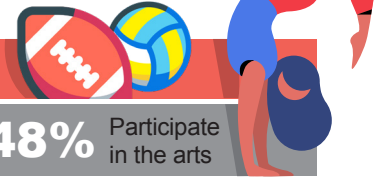
I plan to go to college	88%

CLUBS

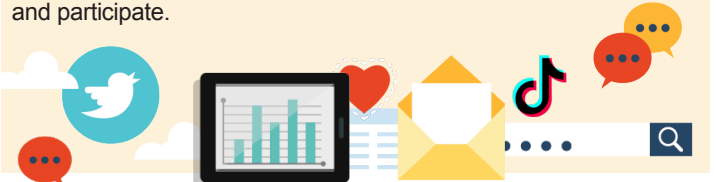
Clubs provide opportunities for students to engage in learning of their choice beyond the classroom.
