The Castle Hills mission

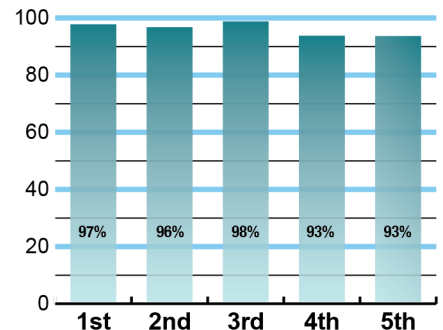
