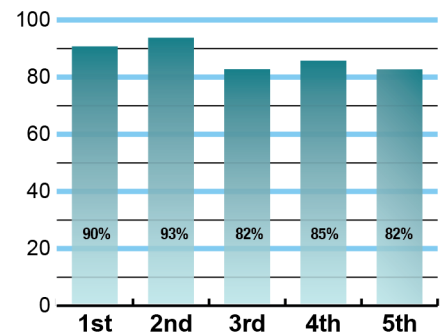

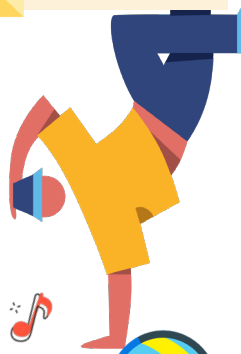
DIGITAL CITIZENSHIP
