At DeLay Middle School, we believe:

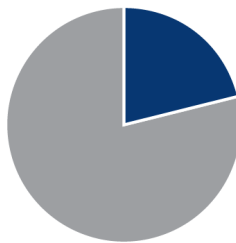
- Every child can learn and achieve at a high level

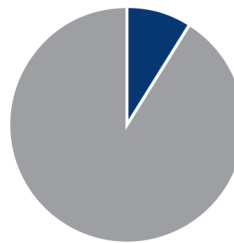
ACADEMIC PERFORMANCE

PSAT SCORES AND ADVANCED COURSES

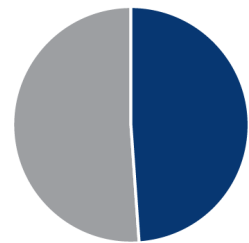
- = Percent of students whose PSAT test scores indicate they are college and career ready.

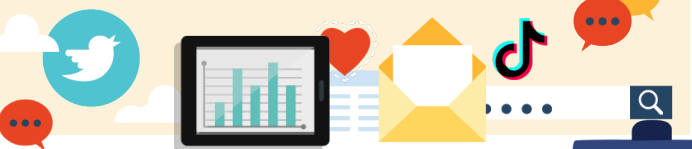
In April 2024, we asked our students about adults they could confide in at our school. Values represent the percentage of students who agreed with the following.

There is a staff member at my school with whom I feel comfortable talking	72%
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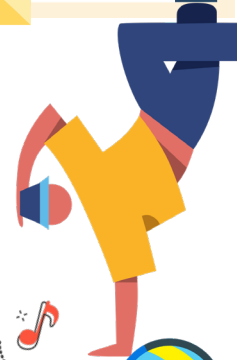
DIGITAL CITIZENSHIP
