Physics

We are very pleased to have adopted a technology rich physics curriculum here in Lewisville ISD, however along with the advantages to such a curriculum there are also a few minor drawbacks. The main disadvantage of such a curriculum is that we are unfortunately unable to offer students a physical textbook to check out and take home as they may have done in past LISD courses. Our campus is currently limited to a single class set which students are welcome to use in class only. We are also no longer printing and running off copies of assignments for every individual student in the physics discipline. Instead, all assignments next year will be available through either the publishers e-course (Ergopedia for Regular/Pre-AP and Pearson's Mastering Physics for AP) or shared with them as .pdf files or Google docs through the physics course Google drive. These files will be accessible on any personal device including windows or mac laptops, iPads or android tablets, chromebooks, iPhones or android cellular phones, etc. In order to access all of these curriculum materials your student is strongly encouraged to take advantage of the district technology initiative and check out an iPad from the school library. A personal computing device is not required for the course, only advised.
